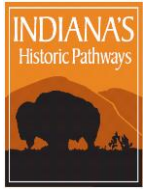

Walk Description:

The popular Milwaukee Road Transportation Trailway, stretches west from Bedford. Walkers will be shuttled west to Coxton Road near Williams in rural Lawrence County. Walkers cross the Salt Creek Bridge, enjoy limestone bluffs, and follow Spider Creek. Along the way can walkers will enjoy tree canopies, scenic waterways, wildflowers, and a variety of wildlife. The walk will continue up a hill to Wilson Park passing a lovely waterfall and finishing the 10K walk in the town of Bedford. The walk will end passing through the restored Milwaukee Depot which was relocated last spring.

The restored trailway is a lovely walk across 17 bridges and the walk through historic Bedford is charming. The walk affords the opportunity to meet several special event criteria.

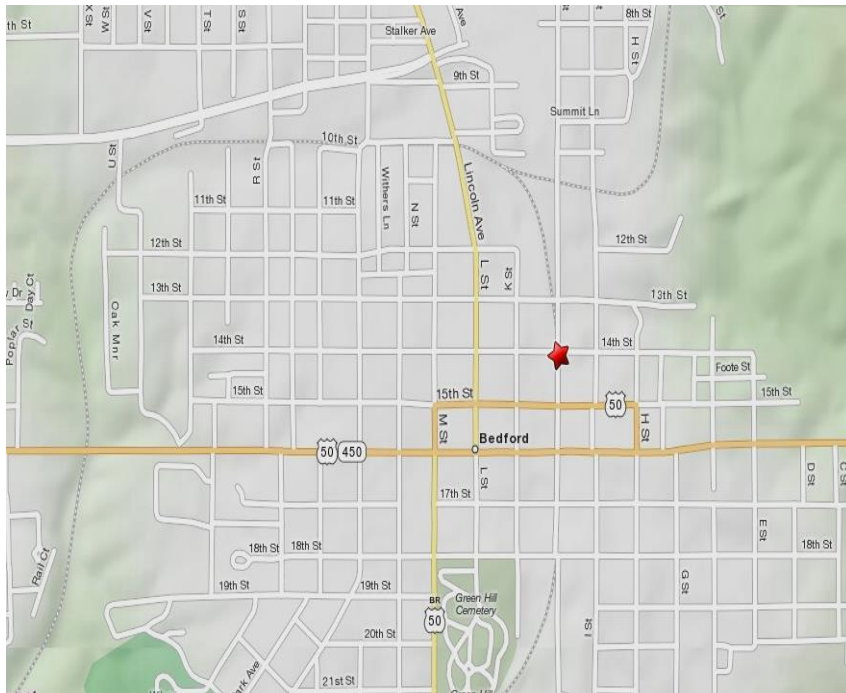

Directions

FROM INDIANAPOLIS: From the north or south, take SR 37 to US 50 East. Go east on US 50 (16th Street) to “M” Street. (CVS and Walgreens on corner) N on “M St” to 14th, turn R; 3 blocks to SP. **(Parking lot behind address)** From the east or west, Take US 50 (16th Street) to “M” Street and follow above directions.

FROM LOUISVILLE Take 60W (exit 7 on I-65) to Salem, then 22 miles west to junction 37 and 60. Turn N on 37 to Bedford. (do not take bypass) Continue through junction (CVS and Walgreens) and follow above directions.
