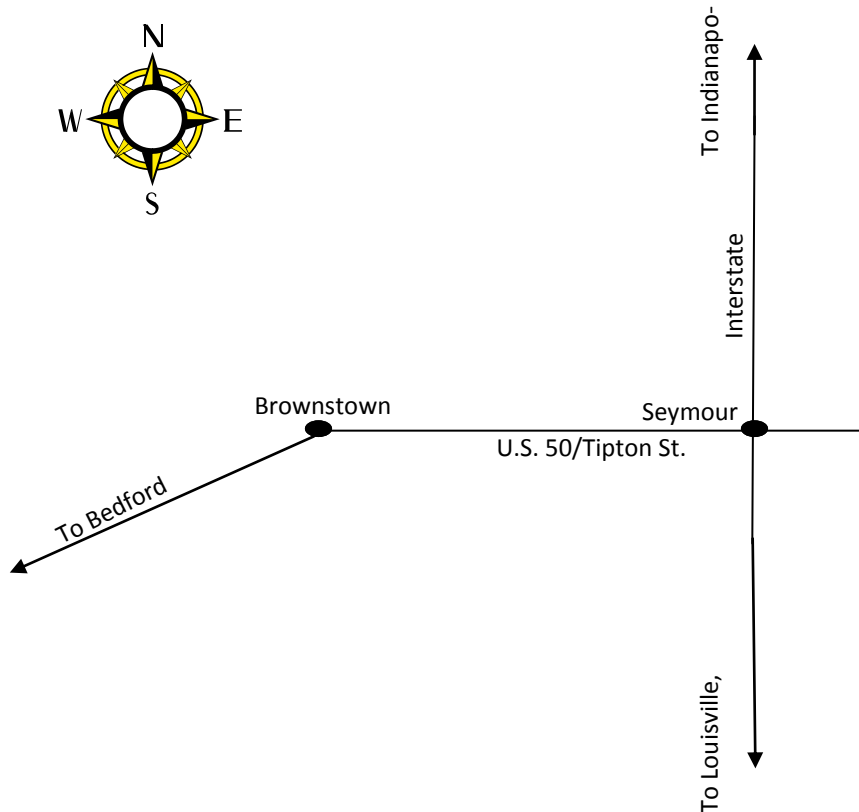
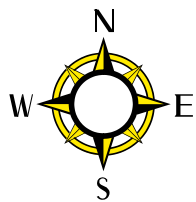


Directions:

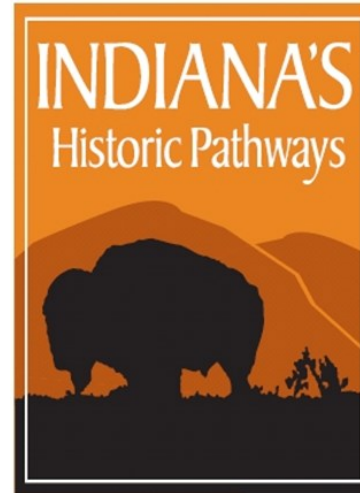
From Bedford: Take U.S. 50 East to Brownstown. Turn left off U.S. 50 at Ewing Street (first left after Flashing Light at Junction of U.S. 50 & State Road 135). Take Ewing Street to Spring Street and turn left onto Spring Street. W. R. Ewing (1105 W. Spring Street) will be on your right.

From I-65: Take exit U.S. 50 for Seymour. Follow U.S. 50 (Tipton St.) West to Brownstown. Turn right off U.S. 50 onto Spring Street. Go 9 Blocks. W.R. Ewing (1105 W. Spring Street) will be on your right.

What is a Volksmarch? A volksmarch is a non-competitive walk along a prescribed trail and is designed to encourage physical fitness, promote camaraderie and to enjoy nature. Walk for fun, fitness, and friendship! It is not a contest of speed or endurance. Each participant is encouraged to walk at a pace that is comfortable and enjoyable.

The trail will be marked. You may also obtain a map and a set of printed instructions at the start point. The event is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV). The event is eligible for credit toward IVV achievement awards. The event will be held rain or shine, so please dress appropriately.

Date: Saturday, April 28, 2014

Location: WR Ewing

Start Time: Start anytime between 9am and 1 pm. (Eastern Daylight)

The 10K people will register @ Spring Street and drive to History Center to start.

Finish Time: You must finish by 4:00 pm (Eastern Daylight)

Registration: All participants, including children, must check in at the registration table and receive a start card. Your start card must be signed before the walk and returned to the finish table upon completion of the walk. This procedure allows us to keep track of all participants.

Awards & Fees:

- The event is FREE for those walking for fun, fitness, and friendship only.
- The fee is \$3.00 for those walking for IVV credit only.
- The fee for IVV credit and the award is \$7.00. (IVV credit and the Brownstown patch only is \$4.00.)

There will be no refunds for any reason.

Trail Description:

The walks will start in Ewing. The 5K will include a walk through the country and observe furnaces of an old brickyard company. The walk is rated 2A.

The 10k, rated 4D will start and end at the History Center . Participants will drive to the History Center to do the 10K walk with views of Brownstown from a high vantage point. The walk includes a steep hill and spectacular view on Skyline Drive which features a primitive forest area which offer vistas of the surrounding woodlands and fertile plain, checkered with farm fields and the roofs of silos and barns . Both walks will view the Jackson County Historical Center and the County Courthouse and the Artsfest.



Pets are welcome on the trail but not inside local businesses unless needed for handicapped access.
