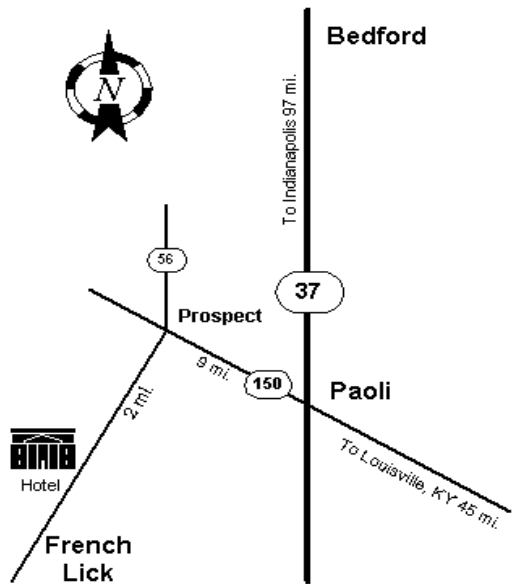


From Indianapolis: take State Road 37 South to Paoli and head west on State Road 150, then west on Indiana 56. The Convention Center is to the Right of the French Lick Resort and Spa and can be seen from Indiana 56 in French Lick.

From Louisville: Take I-64 W. to US-150 W exit, exit number 119, to GREENVILLE/PAOLI. Travel on 150 to Prospect, turn West on IN -56 going thru West Baden Springs to French Lick where the Convention Center can be seen on the right side of Highway 56 in French Lick.

Trail Description

The trail begins and ends at the Convention Center. The route meanders through the towns of French Lick and West Baden on city streets and even through both historic hotels (the West Baden dome is shown here).



The hotels and casino are open and feature many amenities. There is also an historic railroad (below).



Conditions

The event will be held rain or shine. Water will be provided for you and your pets at the start/finish area and at checkpoints. Refreshments will be available at the checkpoints. Restrooms are located at the beginning of the course and points

noted on your map. Pets must be on a leash and under control at all times but are not allowed in the buildings so certain sections of the walk will have to be rerouted or missed.
